Entry

All entries must be on official entry form & accompanied by the appropriate fees.

Closing dates will be strictly adhered to and there will be no late entries. Full refunds will be given to any skiers who do not meet qualifications standards prior to the event or are sick/injured.

Competitors Age is as at 1st July 2009

If a skier is qualified to compete in two events he/she shall be allowed to compete in the third event provided he/she has 2/3rds of the basic qualifying standard in trick and jump, and a course below the qualifying standard in slalom. In the Sub Junior division a skier who is qualified in one event shall be allowed to compete in the second event if he/she has 2/3rds of the trick qualification or a course below the qualification standard in slalom.

All skiers must hold a NZTWSA Rating Card with the Qualification performance or better (achieved after 06/04/2009) entered on the Skier's Log. Skiers must present their Rating Cards at Registration to enable them to ski.

Skiers are asked to enter their best scores on the entry form. Anyone who doesn't supply their scores will be ranked in a random fashion.

This is an important document which affects your legal rights and obligations. Please read it carefully. All competitors must sign this form.

- (1) I have read the Safety Plan for this site; I know the rules associated with this sport and understand the demanding physical nature of the event. I declare as a condition of entry to the event that I have sufficiently trained for this event and am not aware of any illness, injury or any other physical disability which may cause injury or death while participating in the event.
- (2) In the event that I become aware of any medical condition or impairment, or am otherwise sick or injured prior to or during the event, I will notify the Safety Officer and Chief Judge.
- (3) I acknowledge that participating in the event is a dangerous activity and that by such participation I am exposed to certain risks.
- (4) I acknowledge and understand that whilst participating in the event:
 - I may be injured, physically or mentally or may die from various causes including but not limited to, over-exertion, dehydration, cardiac arrest, accidents involving other participants, spectators, officials or accidents caused by my own actions;
 - My personal property may be lost or damaged;
 - I may cause injury to other persons or property;
 - The conditions in which the event is conducted or run may vary without warning;
 - There may be limited facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
 - I assume the risk and responsibility for any injury, death or property damage resulting from my participation in this event.
